

Manchester Memorial High School-POPS minutes

The meeting was called to order at 6:30. 8 members were in attendance.

Secretary's Report: was read and the changes were accepted by Melanie Mondor and seconded by Pam Newell.

Treasurer's Report: Kim read through her report with a beginning balance of 7,983.16 and income from Nadeau's of \$200; 50/50 at the concert \$245. Concessions \$78.76; the basket raffle ticket sales \$841.00 bringing the new balance to \$9,295.16. \$3400. Will goes to the 4 applicates for graduating scholarships. Jenn made a motion to accept and Tammy seconded it.
